Open to Middle and High School PTAs: Sign your school up to participate in California's Student Mock Election where students will vote electronically based on the actual November ballot and get their results to compare to the real election. Open to High School PTAs: Pre-register 16 and 17 year olds to vote. California's High School Voter Registration Weeks, September 15 – 24, are the ideal time to do this.
