#### **TEXT**

The board lists 5 items that need to be fixed. "Halls" and "Town" are the top two concerns, based on the shapes on the hats. Students need to realize that the image is of....

#### DIRECTIONAL

The setup text says the bill will travel. Follow the setup text, including the route other bills will take.

#### **TEXT**

The setup carefully discusses Congress and President disagreeing without using the word "\_\_\_\_\_". The word is formed with the first letter of \_\_\_\_\_\_.

#### TEXT

The setup gives the clue that the Legislative Branch has done its job. The bottom of the bill needs a signature from the (words obscured). The president is the obvious initial guess, but because everything is referring to the branches of government, the correct answer is ".

#### DIRECTIONAL

The justices are judging the bill. The first justice dissents and the other two concur with the decision.
