Marriotts Ridge High School Music is composed of all students and families in the Choral, Band, and Orchestra Performing Ensembles. We believe that every person in the program is valuable and has much to offer. Here at Marriotts Ridge, we strive to provide you with the highest quality program available. In order to fulfill your role as a vital member of the music community, please keep the following information in mind.

Forms/Calendar: Please abide by all of the deadlines set forth in the Music Calendar. You will find the music calendar in Charms (www.charmsoffice.com) and the Music Foundation Website (www.mrhsmusic.net). Please review carefully the calendar of events and resolve conflicts well ahead of time. We will make every effort to update the calendar on a regular basis. You can find all forms on the Music Foundation website (www.mrhsmusic.net) – click on "Forms & Documents" in the left menu bar. Many volunteer hours go into accounting and data management. Please respect our volunteers by turning in forms and payments on time.

Fees and Payments: The preferred method of payment is PayPal/Credit Card through **Charms** for many fees such as Ensemble Fees (a 3% service charge will be added to the cost of the item). You may also make Online Patron Donations via the Music Foundation Website (www.mrhsmusic.net). Otherwise, please make all checks payable to "MRHS Music Foundation" (except Spring Trip Payments -- these should be written to MRHS).

Fundraising: All families will have the opportunity to fundraise to help us improve our equipment and facilities, to help with costs the county does not supplement, and to offset costs of the Spring Trip. Students may also request funds from their student account to assist with Music Foundation Expenses (Ensemble Fees, Marching Band Fees, Concert Attire, Solo & Ensemble Fees, All State Fees). We encourage all families to participate in our fundraisers. Each student in the program will have an individual Student Account where their payments and fundraising efforts will be recorded in the Charms Application. You can view the balance of your Student Account through Charms. **Note: All Fundraising Credits in the Student Account cannot be paid out to the student as cash. Any remaining credits at the end of the school year will be rolled over to the next year for returning students or can be donated to an incoming sibling or another Music Department student.** Seniors who have funds left at the end of the school year may designate these funds to be transferred to another music student or they will revert back to the Music Foundation unassigned funds.

Commitment: All of the performing groups have many rehearsal and performance commitments outside of the school day. Every Student is expected to know their performance and rehearsal schedule. Please make every effort to be ON TIME for these events. Lateness creates unneeded anxiety for everyone. Please make every effort to communicate when emergency situations arise. Chronic lateness and absence from rehearsals and performances will result in lowering of a grade and could lead to dismissal from the music program. It is the Music Foundation's expectation that each family volunteer in one way, shape, or form for at least one event throughout the school year. There are many opportunities to volunteer, and the Music Foundation requires the participation of each family in order to ensure the SUCCESS of the Music Program (see volunteer sheet at the end of this document).



Department Expectations For Music Students

- Students will enter the music suite and classrooms in an orderly and professional manner. Students are expected to be in their rehearsal room by the sounding of the late bell.
- Students will retrieve their necessary equipment, find their seats, and begin appropriate warm-up activities.
- It is the student's responsibility to be prepared with all necessary materials. These materials may include instruments and all necessary accessories, music, pencils and a <u>productive positive attitude</u>.
- Students will treat themselves and each other with the utmost care and respect.
- Students will treat Marriotts Ridge High School's property and their own property with the utmost care and respect.
- Students are expected to meet all of their obligations, both financial and otherwise, to each ensemble
 in which they perform. If at any time there is a financial hardship, please reach out to your director
 immediately.
- There is to be no eating, drinking, gum chewing or personal grooming during class time. All electronic
 devices should be silenced and out of sight or follow the school policy for cell phones during class
 time.
- Students are asked to leave the rehearsal rooms clean and organized. All instruments and materials are to be stored in their appropriate areas.
- Students will uphold and follow all school wide policies and expectations.

The expectation is that each family volunteers for at least one event throughout the school year. Thank you in advance and we can't wait to meet you!

This handbook will be electronically provided and each Student <u>and/or</u> Parent/Guardian will need to "Electronically Sign" that they have read the entire handbook in Charms. (Instructions for this will be in the Charms section of this handbook).

Open Board meetings are held generally on the third Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. in the Student Services Office. Please check MRMF emails and website for location. All Mustang music parents and students are welcome and encouraged to attend!

The primary sources of funds for the Music Foundation are Patron Donations (Family and Business) and Fundraising Campaigns. Funds are needed to continue to build and support the music program here and plan for future growth. Several opportunities are offered throughout the year for students to raise money toward their spring trip and other music related expenses. (See Fundraising and Your Student Account page)

Spring Trip

Each year, prior to the pandemic, the Marriotts Ridge Music Department took an annual Spring Trip. Last year we resumed this annual MRHS tradition with a spring trip to Universal Studios in Orlando, Florida!

Recognizing the high cost of the Florida trip and considerable travel time requirements, the Music Department is currently considering scheduling a mix of day trips and longer distance travel in alternating years for the spring trip. This year, the trip is scheduled to be a multi-day trip (April 18-21) to Myrtle Beach.

We highly encourage our students to take advantage of this opportunity. These trips allow our students to participate in high-level competition with students from various locations and advance the reputation of our school, music department and students.

Our students are able to bond with each other and grow as a music community through these experiences. We have found that these bonds last far beyond high school.

- The Spring Trip is currently planned for April 18th-21st in Myrtle Beach. Please check the music calendar for updates.
- The cost of the trips vary from year to year depending on destination and fuel costs at the time of the trip. Recent trips have ranged from \$140 for a day trip to \$975 for last year's trip to Universal Studios in Orlando, Florida. Due to the shorter distance to Myrtle Beach, this year's trip is expected to be in the range of \$700-900 per person, although lodging, food, and transportation costs have not been finalized at this time.
- Students will have many fundraising opportunities to help defray the cost of their trip. Please do not let the cost discourage you. We believe the experience is well worth it.
- · Families have the option to pay for the trip in advance or follow the payment schedule indicated on the Music Calendar.
- Additionally, the Music Foundation will offer an opportunity for Financial Aid. Specific requirements must be met and all decisions are final. More information will be available in the fall.
- Families will receive a letter of intent in early October, which should be returned with a **non-refundable** deposit. This letter will include a very basic itinerary and schedule.



Music Foundation Fundralsing & Your Student Account

The Music Foundation sponsors several fundraisers throughout the school year which can benefit your Student Account, the Music Foundation or both. Fundraising, family patron donations and business patron donations are the three major sources of income for the Music Foundation. We encourage you to participate in fundraisers to help you offset various expenses, as well as to help the Music Foundation which provides music, instruments, transportation and much more for the MRHS music program.

What is a Student Account?

Your Student Account is a record of money you've either paid by check/cash/OSP for the Spring Trip/Day Trips or earned through the Music Foundation fundraisers and is accessible through your students Charms account. Note: All Fundraising Credits in the Student Account cannot be paid out to the student as cash. Any remaining credits at the end of the school year will be rolled over to the next year for returning students or can be donated to an incoming sibling or another Music Department student. Students may also request funds from their student account to assist with Music Foundation Expenses (Ensemble/Costume Fees, Marching Band Fees, Concert Attire, Solo & Ensemble Fees, All State Fees). Seniors who have funds left at the end of the school year may designate these funds to be transferred to another music student or they will revert back to the Music Foundation unassigned funds.

Here's how fundraisers benefit your Student Account and the Music Foundation:

- World's Finest Chocolates: Students earn \$20 per box sold. Students will only be allowed to check out one box at a time unless they prepay. A student may check out another box AFTER submitting the full \$60 payment for the first box checked out. Please submit payment by check, or cash (NO COINS), to the black box outside the director's offices. Student earnings are deposited into your student account.
- **Cash Cards:** For every Giant or Weis gift card you purchase, your Student Account will receive a 5% profit posted into the student account (4% for Harris Teeter).


The Music Foundation uses a web-based application called Charms that houses the student and parent contact information, tracks Student Account activity (fundraising credits), and the Music Calendar, this Handbook, and provides a vehicle for communication between the Music Foundation, Directors, Students, and Parents.

Each student will have a Charms account and will be REQUIRED to log into Charms and complete various pieces of information – EMAIL and CELL PHONE numbers are **mandatory**. If you are a returning student, your Charms account from last year is still active! All students are required to log in and update your information.

The <u>student and at least one Parent/Guardian</u> will need to create an **eSignature** in Charms and digitally "sign" that you have read this Handbook and understand Student and Parent/Guardian obligations. This will be a GRADED assignment for your student.

Below are the steps to access Charms.

- □ Log on to www.charmsoffice.com, and click "LOG IN" in the upper right corner and then click on the "PARENT/STUDENT/MEMBERS" option.
- ☐ Login to your student's program account using the following School Code and click "Enter Parent Area": MRHSMUSIC
- ☐ This will bring up the main "PUBLIC" page. This will allow you to look at the calendar for the Music Department, event list, forms and handouts and other "publicly shared" files, as well as a few other options. If you are a returning student, enter your password (from last year) in the **Student Area Password** box.
- If you are a new student, the first time you enter Charms, enter your student ID as the password. This will bring up another screen asking you to reset your password. Enter your First and Last Name and enter one of the emails from your Family File account in Synergy the email used will be one of your Parents/Guardians emails on file with the school and click Reset My Password. You will receive a link to reset/set your password. There is ONLY ONE account logon and password used for both STUDENTS and PARENTS. Please share this information with each other.



- ☐ Whenever you enter Charms using the password that was created, another more detailed screen appears, with various button options for you to access areas in the Charms account.
- ☐ The Student and Adult Information areas REQUIRE REVIEW AND UPDATES:
 - o Scroll down and Click on the "Update Info" icon at the bottom of the screen
 - Review and/or Update fields on the Student Detail Screen: It is VERY important that you input a VALID email address and a CELL PHONE NUMBER.
 - Click on the button "Create eSignature". Create your signature and click Submit Signature.
 - Be sure to click the green update button at the top right of the screen or your changes will NOT be saved!



At the bottom of the Student Detail Page are links to "Adults" that have been added to your account. **Please review and/or update ALL Required fields on this screen**: It is VERY important that you input a VALID email address and a CELL PHONE NUMBER. At least one Adult is required to **Click on the button "Create eSignature"**.

Music Foundation Cash Cards

4 or 5% PROFIT FOR STUDENT ACCOUNTS:

For every Giant or Weis gift card you purchase, your student's account will receive a 5% profit. (e.g.: every \$100 purchased = \$5.00 profit to your student account! \$50 purchased = \$2.50 profit to your student account).

For every Harris Teeter gift card you purchase, your student's account will receive a 4% profit (e.g.: every \$100 purchased = \$4.00 profit to your student account! \$50 purchased = \$2.00 profit to your student account).

You can find the order form online at mrhsmusic.net and next to the black drop box by the school's music office.

Please fill out the form and instruct your student to place it in the black drop box with your payment by check by each Tuesday. Orders are collected every other Tuesday by 2:40pm. The orders are filled and given to the Directors by that Friday morning. On those Fridays, students should let their director know they have a cash card order to pick up unless the parent has made other arrangements.

How Does The Cash Cards Fundraiser Work?

We purchase Giant, Weis and Harris Teeter Gift Cards at a discount and sell them to you for face value. The 4% or 5% difference is profit for your student if the Cash Card order form is used. Your neighbors, relatives, and family friends will be able to support your child by purchasing the cards via the order form!

There is no limit to the number of cards you can purchase from us – you just shop as you normally would, pay with the gift card, and the profits go into your student's account.

There is no fee for using Giant, Weis and Harris Teeter gift cards. Giant Gift Cards can be redeemed at any of the Giant Food and Pharmacy stores operating in Maryland, Delaware, DC and Virginia. It may be possible to redeem at Martin's, Peapod, and Stop&Shop but not guaranteed. Weis gift cards can be redeemed anywhere in the continental U.S.

All cards are non-refundable and are not redeemable for cash, but may be redeemed for any prescription purchases. The cards never expire and no fees are assessed.

Concert Attire Information

ALL ENSEMBLES

Students in all music ensembles must purchase the "concert black" official MRHS Concert Attire for \$60-\$77, depending on style choice. Styles include long black evening gown, black blouse / palazzo pants combo, and black dress shirt / dress slacks / tie combo. Concert Attire fittings will take place September 26-28 in the evenings at MRHS. A signup genius link will be made available to make fitting appointments. Volunteers will measure students and assist in selecting sizes and styles and completing the order form. The order form will be sent home with the student.

*** NEW PROCESS THIS YEAR: Parents/guardians will be responsible for placing the order for the attire directly with our vendor, Cousin's Concert Attire. Clothes will be distributed in class. There will be a one-week period for all size exchanges to be returned to MRHS for a free size/style exchange. If the student misses the return window, parents will be responsible for exchanging clothing with the vendor directly.

All gowns and pants require hemming, as they come with unfinished hems, so attire must be hemmed in time for performances.

Students must wear dressy black shoes and black socks or hose with the concert attire. Families must provide the shoes and socks/hose.

Consignment – Graduating students may donate their used attire to the MRHS Music Foundation for future students to purchase at a discount. Current students may purchase these used garments instead of new garments. Consignment sales will be available at the time of fittings and can be paid using cash, check or credit card that evening.

ADDITIONAL ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC ENSEMBLES

CHORAL GROUPS:

MADRIGALS - Renaissance & Evening attire - \$80 rental fee

- Madrigal Men will be required to purchase a Tuxedo fittings will be done at the same time as Concert Attire – you will be contacted by a Madrigal Costume Coordinator for specific dates/times
- Shoes & other accessories as designated by director (provided by student)

WOMEN'S ENSEMBLE - Women's gown - \$35 rental fee

Silver shoes (provided by student)

BAND GROUPS:

JAZZ ENSEMBLE - Jazz Vest - \$15 rental fee

For students in the Jazz Band/Big Band, Madrigals, and Women's Ensemble, additional garments are required. Please order and pay the maintenance fee(s) for the garment(s) you need for your ensemble below.

- Please attach a check payable to <u>Marriotts Ridge Music Foundation</u>. Or you may pay via Charms under your Account (a 3% service fee will be added to amounts at check out).
- Be sure to include Student Name, Ensemble Name(s) & item(s) ordered in check memo line to ensure accurate accounting. Be sure to include all ensembles if ordering attire for more than one group.

Immediate Volunteer Opportunities:

Concert Attire: The bulk of the work in this area happens in the fall: measuring incoming freshmen and new students for their concert attire, ordering and then distributing concert attire in time for our first performances. The concert attire supplier is established and a veteran parent is coordinating this year.

Madrigals Attire: Maintain attire inventory with student attire assignments, arrange order of men's tuxes or other attire as needed, distribute attire to Madrigals early in school year, ensure attire is maintained and available for all Madrigal performances, collect attire after last performance, updating inventory list, contact families who haven't returned attire & bill them if not returned, arrange for returned attire to be dry-cleaned (using Music Fdtn approved company)

Cash cards: Year Round position, fill cash card orders received in the black box, purchase cards from Harris Teeter, Weis & Giant, distribute cards to directors via the black box, maintain spreadsheet for orders and forward to CHARMS manager & bookkeeper

Family & Business Patron Coordinators: Record keeping is an important part of this job. Although most Family Patron donations are received in the fall, responsibility to record and acknowledge contributions is ongoing throughout the school year. On the Business Sponsor side, it is a wonderful way to get involved with the community. Patron coordinators contact past patrons and identify potential new contributors and encourage them to support the MRHS Music Foundation. If you want to help but prefer to work independently or if you have lots of local business contacts and like to network, our Patron Program welcomes your involvement

Spring Trip Co-Coordinators: Planning begins in September, trip is usually April, work closely with the directors, the trip company, various vendors and the Student Accounts manager to coordinate all aspects of the trip.

Concert Box Office: Needed for Winter Concerts, Jazz at the Ridge, and Spring Concerts, ensure there are enough tickets in stock, organize volunteers to run box office, mind the doors, hand out programs, count money and deliver to Treasurer

Back to School Staff Meal: Organize Back to School breakfast for MRHS staff (before school year starts), arrange Sign-up Genius for donations & volunteers, take stock / purchase paper products, order & pick up food, set up & clean up

Jazz at the Ridge: Held in April, promote & organize event by coordinating with jazz band director, purchase dinner for visiting jazz performers

World's Finest Chocolates: Typically Sep – Jan, order from WFC, track boxes checked out by students in CHARMS, collect funds from black box and enter into CHARMS, send reminder emails from Charms for collection of outstanding funds
