Food & Water Distribution Centers

- Bottled Water Distribution: Rosman Town Hall (6 Main St, Rosman, NC 28772)
- General State of Water in the County:
 - “Power has been restored to the Brevard water treatment plant. Water service has been partially restored to the Town of Rosman, but is under a boil water advisory. Bottled water has been delivered to Rosman Town Hall. Be sure to boil water or use bottled water if your well or spring has been contaminated by flood water. Emergency management will be coordinating with fire departments to identify community needs and get resources distributed. If you are in need of water, reach out to your local fire department. Wells that were in flood waters should not be used for cooking or drinking until tested and treated.”
- While many local charities and churches are sharing food, water, and other supplies to those in need, the main location for mass dispersal of those items is Anchor Baptist Church at 3232 Hendersonville Highway. Here's a list of other locations in the county: (Levans@gannett.com; 10/4)

- The Cedar Mountain Community Center, 10635 Greenville Highway, offers meals from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m., noon to 2 p.m., and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.
- The Balsam Grove Community Center at 9732 Parkway Road provides meals from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- The Bread of Life at 238 S. Caldwell St. serves meals from noon to 2 p.m.
- Starting Friday, Oct. 4, meals will be served at Rosman High School Old Gym, 749 Pickens Hwy, at 5:30 p.m. and again on Saturday, Oct. 5, at 8 a.m. and noon.
- Sharing House provides essential services, including showers, food, and clothing. Thanks to a significant influx of in-kind donations, volunteers, and funding, they offer expanded assistance for community members, including help with rental deposits and appliance replacements. FEMA assistance is available on-site. 164 Duckworth Ave, Brevard.

- Shelters remain open at the Transylvania County Parks and Recreation Center and the Ag Center at the Asheville Airport. The Shelter is NOT a distribution site for supplies and does not have food, fuel, medical supplies or water to distribute. Those in need of medical supplies are encouraged to reach out to their providers or pharmacies and to the ER in a medical emergency.
