The Hanoverian is a powerful, noble, and robust horse with a large, rectangular frame, harmonious conformation, and light, elastic movements with great impulsion. The breed has a strong back, pronounced withers, sloping shoulders, muscular hindquarters, and a deep girth.

Hanoverians' powerful legs have large, pronounced joints, short cannon bones, and sloping pasterns. Their hooves are well-shaped, strong, and sound. They have a well-proportioned neck and a refined head with expressive eyes. They are willing and trainable, excelling in a huge variety of disciplines.

Chestnut, bay, black, and gray are found the most often. Regulations prohibit horses with too much white, and buckskin, palomino, and cremello horses from being registered.
