




Setting up the iPad




Connect to a Wi-Fi network

1. From the dock on the iPad, open the Settings , go to Settings > Wi-Fi.
2. Tap the name of the Wi-Fi network that you want to join and enter the network's password. To connect the Wi-Fi at school, select BET-WiFi and use your child's school account username (e.g., dsmith25) and password.

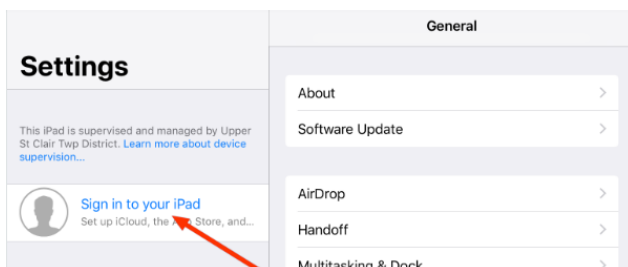
After you've joined the network, you'll see a blue tick  next to the network and the connected Wi-Fi icon  in the top right-hand corner of your display. The school required apps will then be installed automatically.

Set a passcode

1. Open Settings , then tap Touch ID & Passcode
2. Tap Turn Passcode On
3. Input a 6-digit passcode, then tap Next
4. Input the same passcode again, then tap Done

Sign in to the new iPad

Open Settings , then tap Sign into your iPad with an Apple ID.



School Apple IDs are designed to provide access to essential iCloud services used in education, along with features built specifically for schools.

The main benefit of using a school Apple ID is the **200GB of free iCloud storage** it

provides, compared with only 5GB on a personal Apple ID (unless extra storage is purchased). This makes it much easier to back up your iPad.

However, you will not be able to download additional apps when signed in with a school Apple ID.

Please note: Children under the age of 13 cannot create an Apple ID on their own.

Apps installed by the personal Apple ID will disappear during the school day but will come back after school hours (8:00-16:30).

Setting up your school email

To access your school email, please open the **Outlook app** installed on your iPad and log in using your school email address. Your email will follow the format:



Firstnamesurname25@bohunt.hants.sch.uk Enter your password, then select **Office 365** (not *Exchange*) to complete the login.

Parental controls on the iPad

Jamf Parent is an app that allows you to manage your children's school managed device. Using Jamf Parent, you can restrict and allow apps and device functionality on your children's device. You can download the Jamf Parent app by scanning the QR codes below and watch the tutorial to get started with the Jamf Parent app.

iPad Scheme

If you bought your child's iPad through the school scheme, please note the insurance cover:

- Accidental damage (with a £24 excess per claim)
- Mechanical warranty

For orders placed before August 2025, this cover runs until September 2027 (2-year plan) or September 2028 (3-year plan). Edutech will contact you before the insurance expires.
