Social Media Monitoring Toolkit

Included here are types of problems as well as examples of search strings you can use to identify this kind of content. You will have to make your own search strings specific to the election and your context.

Search strings are used to find files and their content, database information, and web pages. A search string may include keywords, numeric data and operators.

These categories are helpful to think through the kinds of terms to search for, and the search strings are for examples.

Types of Problems

Voter Suppression

- Required to vote via provisional ballot
- Couldn't vote (see <u>search strings</u>, below)
- Long lines
- Coronavirus related issues
- Drop box issues
- Absentee ballot issues
 - Didn't receive ballot in time
- Poll worker problems
- Polling place locations
 - Polling place changed
 - Polling place inaccessible
 - Polling place not open when it should be

Mis- and Dis-information

Deceptive practices

- A person posts the wrong date/time of the election
 - For example, Democrats (or Republicans) vote on Wednesday (or whatever date the day after the election), or the election is postponed.
- A person posts the wrong location to vote
- A person posts the wrong process to vote (texting your vote) or registering to vote

- "Text HERE to vote for x candidate"
- Posting wrong links to register to vote or find your polling place
- A person posts wrong information about ID requirements. Examples include:
 - Sharing incorrect info about eligibility of a person to cast a <u>provisional ballot</u> if the voter has no ID.
- A person posts false information about voter registration, such as deadlines, who is eligible, etc. Examples include:
 - "If you voted in the primary or any election this year, you're not allowed to vote in the general"
 - Information stating voters can wait until election day to register (this may not be true for all states and can therefore suppress the vote)
- A person posts Incorrect info about eligibility after moving (specifically moving from Puerto Rico to the mainland US).
 - Incorrect info about residency requirements for voter eligibility
 - Incorrect info about requirements for students voting
- A person posts wrong information about ability to vote regarding criminal records.
 Examples include:
 - "If you or anyone in your family/household has been convicted of a crime, you can't vote."
 - Incorrect information about voting after conviction. Find the state laws regarding criminal convictions <u>here</u>
 - Incorrect info about student voting at permanent address.
 Incorrect info about whether provisional ballot or absentee ballot will be counted.

Coronavirus related

- Polling place doesn't have proper PPE
 - There is a sick person at polling place
- A person or polling place is making a claim about masks and voting
 - A voter was was denied the right to vote because they didn't wear a mask
 - IA voter ID not accepted because they were wearing mask
- Curbside voting problems
 - A voter denied curbside voting
 - o other curbside polling problems

Intimidation

- Police present at the polls / looking for people with warrants, etc.
- ICE present at the polls / looking for immigration violations, etc.
- Armed citizens will be at the polls.
- Polls in specific communities will be targeted for ballot security / challenges / election observers.
- Warnings about voter fraud or severe consequences like prison and having your children taken away.

- Doxxing of election workers, volunteers, voters, etc.
- Calls to boycott voting (probably beyond the scope of deceptive practices)

False Flags

- People will post false reports of problems
 - False report of delays in voting
 - False report of polling place closing
 - False report of machine issues or issues with the counts and tallies
 - False reports of results
 - Election Day messages that X candidate already won/lost and supporters don't need to vote.
 - Reporting wrong results of who won
 - o Or "X candidate" won this state" so no reason to vote
- A person posts "voting is a privilege not a right some people deserve/can exercise this privilege, others cannot."

A note on less mainstream platforms:

We have experts monitoring in far right spaces like 4chan, Parler, and others. We want our volunteers to stay safe - experts who infiltrate from Common Cause and affiliate research forms all use alternate identities to stay safe - we don't want any volunteers in harms' way! As a volunteer, you bring unique utility because you can see content online at the grassroots level that other everyday people also see! Moreover, these other platforms are largely echo chambers that are unlikely to remove or flag content.

Search Terms

You can search for combinations of specific terms pulled from the strings below. The best way to go about this is to put "TERM A" connected with AND/OR with "TERM B". For example, If I wanted a tweet that had the keywords voting and coronavirus, I would search for "voting" AND "coronavirus". If i wanted a tweet that had the keywords voting or coronavirus, I would search for "voting" OR "coronavirus." This is called a **Boolean Search. This search type works on Tweet Deck (Twitter).**

Responding To Online Voter Suppression

Helping Voters

- When we enter the post-election stage of our monitoring, we will no longer prioritize cases of voter assistance. See the next section for more important tasks!
- If a voter asks a simple question, you can answer it with proper information and a link to a trusted source (Secretary of State office, election official, Common Cause, 866OurVote etc.)
- If the guestion is complicated, encourage the voter to call 866-OUR-VOTE.

Fighting Disinformation:

- Our collaboration and tracking platform is called Junkipedia. Use the <u>Social Media Monitoring Incident Report Form</u> to submit examples to our staff who will then submit to Junkipedia. Please fill out all the fields. Please share as much information as possible about the piece of disinformation you are reporting.
 - Be sure to take a screenshot of the content in case it gets deleted. A good tool to use is MonoSnap for Mac, Windows and Chromebooks. There are also keyboard shortcuts you can use to take screenshots. Or you can check out this great guide.
 - A link to the content is also really helpful so please try to include that too!
- Use the form for each tweet, post, proactive content that you post, etc and submit
- If you think you are seeing a major issue or problems you have questions on, post the screenshot on Slack!
