Domestic Payment Methods for Registration Fees

Method 1: Internet banking (NEFT / RTGS / IMPS)

When to use: any bank transfer from your bank's web portal.

Steps:

1. Log in to your bank's internet-banking portal.
2. Go to *Payments / Fund Transfer / Add Beneficiary*.
3. Choose transfer type: **NEFT** (regular), **RTGS** (large amounts), **IMPS** (instant).
4. Add beneficiary details: name, account number, account type, bank name, branch, **IFSC code**.
5. The bank usually sends OTP / requires transaction PIN to confirm beneficiary addition.
6. Once the beneficiary is authorized (may be instant or take a few minutes/hours depending on bank), go to *Transfer Funds*.
7. Enter amount, reason/narration, choose IMPS/NEFT/RTGS, confirm details and approve with OTP/TPIN.
8. Save/print the transaction reference for tracking.

Notes: IMPS is instant (small limits), NEFT/RTGS have different limits and settlement characteristics depending on country/bank.

Method 2: Mobile banking app

When to use: quick transfers on phone.

Steps:

1. Open your bank's mobile app and log in (biometrics/MPIN).
2. Tap *Transfer or Pay* → *To Bank Account / Other Bank*.

3. Add beneficiary: full name, account number, IFSC, branch.
4. Verify via OTP / app challenge.
5. After the beneficiary is active, choose the amount and transfer method (IMPS/NEFT/RTGS if available).
6. Approve transaction using OTP/MPIN/biometric.

Notes: Several apps allow “Pay to Account” using account+IFSC even when you normally use UPI.

Method 3: UPI (if you only have account + IFSC)

When to use: fast, low-cost. UPI normally needs a **VPA (e.g., name@bank)**, but many apps have an option to pay directly to **Account number + IFSC**.

Steps:

1. Open your UPI app (Google Pay, PhonePe, BHIM, etc.).
2. Choose *Bank transfer* or *Send to account* (or *New beneficiary*).
3. Enter beneficiary name, account number, IFSC.
4. Confirm and enter the amount, approve with UPI PIN.
5. Transactions usually complete instantly.

Notes: If the app doesn't support account+IFSC it will need the beneficiary's VPA/U PI ID.
