







## How to Sign in Student iPads

You **must** sign in to student iPads to use rostered classes in Apple Classroom and Schoolwork.

<p>1. On the student iPad, open Settings. Tap on Sign in to your iPad.</p>	
<p>2. Tap Sign in Manually on the menu that opens.</p>	
<p>3. Enter the student's school email address in the Apple ID box:</p> <p><u><a href="mailto:studentnumber@st.brevardschools.org">studentnumber@st.brevardschools.org</a></u></p>	
<p>4. Enter the temporary password. It has been reset to 1 2 3 4 for all students.</p> <p><i>Note: If the temp password does not work, you can either reset it in the Apple classroom or your tech can change it in Apple School Manager.</i></p>	



## How to Sign in Student iPads

5. On the next screen that opens, enter the temporary password again.	
6. You will be prompted to add a new password. Use your 4 digit school number.	
7. Verify the password by entering it again.	
8. You will see a screen that shows that the student is being signed in. You will see your student's name at the bottom.	
9. If a window opens that asks you to merge with iCloud, tap Merge.  Your student is now signed in.
