AIR CANADA - OUR OFFICIAL AIRLINE PARTNER FOR THE FORUM

As the official airline sponsor for the Forum, Air Canada has agreed to facilitate economy class travel of all advisors coming from the US and Canada. The cost for economy class per advisor will be CAD/USD10 plus all applicable taxes/surcharges, including carrier

surcharge. The exact cost will be dependent on point of origin and transit airports (if any). Where another carrier is required/requested in connection with the Air Canada trans-Pacific flight, either for transborder or intra-Asia, an upcharge will apply.

Air Canada has blocked a limited number of Business and Premium Economy seats on the flight between Vancouver and Bangkok on January 11th. The same applies to the return flight on January 20th between Bangkok and Vancouver. Upgrades are subject to availability and additional costs.

Upgrade Costs: The flat rate to upgrade on the Vancouver/Bangkok transpacific flight on 11 JAN and 20 JAN will be CAD/USD1000 each way for Business and CAD/USD400 each way for Premium Economy. Above this allocation or on alternate dates*, the upgrade fee will be subject to availability as follows: Business P-class CAD/USD1000 (ow), Z-class CAD/USD1200 (ow), D-class CAD/USD1600 (ow), and Premium Economy A-class CAD/USD400 (ow), E-class CAD/USD600 (ow)* - Agents will be able to check class availability in their GDS systems

Air Canada will require your details to prepare the airline bookings. This will include your surname/last name and given names as they appear on your passport, passport number, passport expiry date, gender, date of birth, phone number, email address, desired origin and travel dates, your Aeroplan (or STAR Alliance member) number, as well as emergency contact details, and any special dietary requirements.

Should you wish to book with Air Canada, please advise your respective Marketing Manager for USA: steve@tatny.com or for Canada: kayla@tatcan.com and an excel link will be forwarded that you will need to complete and send back.

For reference, below are the convenient same-day one-stop connection markets from the US via Vancouver to Bangkok: SEA, PDX, SFO, LAX, SAN, DEN, IAH, ORD, EWR, MIA (one-way). And these are cities with a good connection (<4hrs) one-way and a long connection the other way: SNA, SMF, PSP, LAS. From the East US, Air Canada serves nearly 40 markets, but these require a two-stop routing and may require an overnight in YYZ/YUL in one direction. US advisors can check AC.com for possible routings from their desired point of origin.

IF YOU PREFER TO TRAVEL ON A DIFFERENT AIRLINE:

The Tourism Authority of Thailand will provide a USD1000 air credit toward your international air to Thailand. This air credit does not apply to any complimentary/free ticket or air transportation arranged through use of points or air miles. To redeem the air credit, please contact Chad@tatny.com and Rathapong@tatny.com and they will provide you with a google link for the required information that will include:

- 1. A copy of your e-ticket and flight itinerary
- 2. A copy of your invoice or receipt reflecting the applicable charges for your transportation

- 3. A copy of your passport
- 4. Your bank wire transfer information* that would enable our office to transfer the funds

*info required to include: Name on account, Beneficiary Account Number, Swift Code, Routing Number (Wire), Bank Name, and Bank Address

Please note that the reimbursement will be made only after the trip has finished.

ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS?

Besides the costs associated with international air to Thailand, each participating advisor will be required to pay an administrative fee of USD250. This cost will cover gratuities and other incidental expenses. Each advisor will also be responsible for securing travel and health insurance for this trip. Moreover, any incidentals incurred over and above F&B provided as part of this trip will be at the advisors own expense.

THIS IS A GROUP TRIP

This is a group trip and not an individual fam. It therefore means that everyone, cannot be on their own time, do as you do; or always agree with you. Please remember to be patient and considerate of others. We ask that you build friendly alliances that are inclusive of all fam trip attendees. The only prize to be won is to leave Thailand with a better appreciation for the Thailand product. Take the time to get to know everyone, you never know what you might discover. We also ask that you avoid any discussions surrounding sensitive topics — especially politics.

PLEASE AND THANK YOU

Thai People are kind and gentle by nature. That gentle demeanor should not be disrespected. "Please" and "thank you" go a long way in Thailand. Ask your guide how to say please and thank you in Thai – Thai People really appreciate those who try to speak their native tongue.

SPICE IS PART OF THAI LIFE

Spice is a staple ingredient of most food in Thailand. Mild can be hot to the average westerner. To expect food with no spice is unrealistic. We have asked all hotels etc. to keep the food as mild as possible. If you accept to participate on a Tourism Thailand sponsored trip, and will not eat Asian food, all meals will be at your expense. This trip, like all others, will include Asian cuisine as well as western cuisine. If you wish for any other cuisine at a specific dining location during this trip, it would be at your expense. Keep in mind that western food is not readily available at all local Thai/Asian restaurants.

We have notified each hotel as well as our local DMC of your food allergies, restrictions and preferences – if any.

TIPPING

This can get very complicated so we have come up with one figure that you can work with. As you may know, much of the guides and drivers rely on tips to augment their income. While it is not mandatory, we ask that you adhere to our suggestion.

The total contribution by each agent will be US\$250 for the entire trip. That amount will cover the guide and driver as well as some of the other activities that will require tipping. You can give this money to your TAT representative upon arrival. US or Canadian cash will be fine.

The following is to help you with other tips (not included in the \$250) that you may wish to provide:

- Delivery of luggage to your room: 80-100 baht About \$1US per bag
- Pick up of luggage from hotel room to the van: 80-100 baht (this gets tricky because the bags might change hands, but just try to pay attention to who is helping) About \$1US per bag
- Tip after a massage minimum of \$10US

ACCESSING CASH WHILE IN THAILAND

If you wish to travel with cash, the best and most convenient place for currency exchange is immediately after immigration at the Bangkok airport while waiting for your luggage. The rate of exchange at the airport is lower than at other locations in Bangkok. Our suggestion is that you change a small amount at the airport so that you can have some Thai baht with you. Larger amounts will receive a better rate of exchange at locations within Bangkok or beyond. Larger notes also receive a slightly higher rate of exchange than smaller notes.

Thai financial institutions are particular in terms of what notes they will accept. Please try your best to travel with notes that are not creased, folded, written on, have slight tears etc. The newer the note the better. I know!!! :

To access Thai baht in cash, I recommend using ATM machines which are located everywhere. Not all ATM machines take every kind of card but look for your credit card logo on the ATM signs. Major credit cards (American Express, Master Card and VISA) are accepted at all major banks, restaurants, hotels and shops. When you visit the night markets, use Thai baht and barter.

COVID has had an impact on many services, so we apologize if anything specific to accessing cash has changed. We will do our very best to ensure that you have access to ATM machines to access Thai cash or currency exchange.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION YOU WILL NEED TO KNOW

The Monarchy: That people have a deep, traditional reverence for the Royal Family, and a <u>visitor should be careful to show respect</u> for the King, the Queen and all members of the Royal Family.

Cultural sensitivity is also important when interacting with Thai monks. Please be discreet and distance yourself when taking photos. Moreover, women should never touch Thai monks. There will be several places that we request that you refrain from taking photos.

WHAT TO PACK

It will be hot in Thailand. Loose fitting clothing especially for daily activity is recommended. Shorts, capri's are fine for days when there are no visits to temples.

When visiting a Thai Buddhist temple, wear light weight, long trousers to your shoes or a skirt that falls below your knees. You will also have to take off your shoes when entering temples, and we suggest something that can be slipped on and off easily. May we also suggest bringing a small pair of socks if you prefer to not walk barefoot. Men and women should have their shoulders covered when visiting temples as well.

BUSINESS CARDS – It is customary to exchange business cards when you visit a hotel either for a site inspection or overnight stay.

- Evening functions smart but casually elegant is appropriate. No shorts or flip flops or sneakers for dinners/lunches or site inspections. A comfortable skirt or dress pants (linen for example) with a nice top would be fine. An evening resort type dress is also perfectly fine. Open toe sandals are perfectly fine.
- We will be hosted by several leading 5-star hotels and resorts therefore I am sure you will want to dress smartly to represent yourself first and your company as well.
- Bring a pair of comfortable sneakers or shoes that you wear to exercise
- Bring your swimwear there will be an opportunity to swim.

- Bring lots of sun block.
- Bring a good pair of sunglasses
- Bring comfortable walking shoes easy on/off is best and most convenient
- Bring a hat.
- Bring your camera
- Bring a whole heap of laughter, patience, tolerance
- Most of all, bring yourself!

PERSONAL INCIDENTALS

You will be responsible for all your personal incidentals at each of the hotels at which you will be staying. These include, for example, items from the mini bar, room service ordered by you, telephone calls, alcoholic beverages, etc. Room service is always at a cost. Please do not expect, insist or force the hotel to absorb these costs. While breakfast is included with your stay, ordering breakfast via room service is not included unless otherwise stipulated by the hotel.

Most hotels will host a dinner for the group. Usually this includes a set menu. The set menu should take into consideration all the dietary restrictions and food preferences. Ordering directly from the menu will be at a cost to you. You should not expect the hotel to pick up the cost of food over and above what was prepared for you.

EXCESS BAGGAGE

Domestic airlines in Thailand allow a 20kg free baggage allowance. We have made the necessary arrangements for you to receive an additional 10 kg at no cost. Anything over that will incur a charge. We ask that you take this into consideration when packing for this trip. Should your bag exceed the allowable weight, you will be responsible for the cost of excess weight.

Suggested best practices for filming for social media: OVERALL

- · All videos should be casual and relaxed in nature. They should not come across as hardcore sales initiatives as viewers will tune everything out if the sales portion is too aggressive.
- · Videos should be 1-minute in length or less so that they can live on IG Feed.

Practice and prepare.

· Your videos shouldn't be overly scripted or rehearsed, but it's always a good idea to have a plan in place. Ahead of your recording, create a loose script and run through what you want to say. This will reduce the chances of mistakes while you're live. It's also good to have an idea of how long your video will be.

Check list

- · Ring/Selfie Light
- · Mic/earpiece for audio
- Strong wifi connection
- · Background of the video avoid messy backgrounds with trash or with the light source facing the camera. It's good to have the light source shine from behind the camera.

ON CAMERA

- · Film yourself before to see how you look and perform on camera and see how you can improve
- · Smile often but not too much
- · Pretend the camera is your best friend

WHAT TO WEAR

- · Choose comfortable clothes that make you feel like an expert.
- · Avoid any dangling/loud accessories or jewelry as they might be picked up by a mic.
- If you wear glasses, take them off or wear contacts. Glasses are notorious for reflecting light and the set back into the camera. People want to see your eyes, not the soft-boxes on the set.






