  - iii. 3. Could the above be signaled to faculty so they know in Blackboard real time through the add/drop period who is enrolled in the course, who is waitlisted, and who is OU and pending enrolled (subject to space being available on the date when OU students are allowed to enroll)?
  - iv. 4. With respect to instructional technology available to be or currently loaned to students, can COBRA get a complete inventory of this loaner equipment and its purchase/replacement cost and which budget element paid for it A2E2, CARES relief, etc.?
  - v. 5. With respect to instructional technology given to students in the last 2 years, can COBRA get a complete inventory of all such equipment, when it was given out, its purchase cost and which budget element paid for it A2E2, CARES relief, etc.?
  - vi. 6. With respect to instructional technology available to be or currently loaned to students, can COBRA get a summary of which equipment has asset tags and which do not?
  - vii. 7. With instructional technology loaned to students, can COBRA get a summary of how that equipment was and is made available to students and the role currently played by the library?
