KS2 SATs Week Arrangements (Monday 9th - Friday 13th May).

It is that time of year when our Year 6 children have to face their biggest challenge - the Standard Assessment Tests. In order to give the children the best chance of succeeding, we have made the following change to morning times. Please ensure these times are adhered to as it could impact your child's ability to achieve well if they miss out.

Y6 Children MUST be in school by 08:15 this week

08:15	Children attend Y6 breakfast Pupils will be provided with a range of cereal options and toast to ensure they do not get hungry during the test.
08:30 - 08:40	Breakfast Ends Once pupils have finished eating, class teachers will deliver a positivity / mental health & well-being starter to ensure all pupils are comfortable / iron out any anxieties the pupils may have about the tests.
08:40	Warm Up Activities So that the pupils aren't going into the tests 'cold', staff will be introducing SAT style questions and providing knowledge reminders that will be useful in that day's scheduled assessments

Can you do anything to help at this stage?

Most definitely! The children will be expected to sit a 20 word spelling test on Monday 9th May. Helping them learn to spell as many of these words as possible will give them an advantage (the word lists will be attached at the end of this newsletter).

Similarly, multiplication (times tables) knowledge underpins many aspects of the maths assessments - regularly practising these over the weekend will keep them fresh in the children's minds for Monday. Times Table Rock Stars log-ins have been shared previously but please get in touch if you need these for the weekend to help practise.
