



Grades 6-8 School Supply List

Required Items

- Laptop, desktop computer, or Chromebook (students cannot complete work on a tablet or phone)
- High Speed Internet Access
- Webcam (if not built into computer)
- Headset with microphone

Recommended Items

- Printer or access to print when necessary (in most cases, we will have online workarounds if you cannot print)
- If you do not have access to print your weekly calendar, we strongly recommend a calendar or daily agenda to write down assignments
- Binder with dividers (and paper to fill) or one notebook per subject for taking notes
- Pencils
- Pens
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers
- Highlighters
- Small dry erase board and markers to work out math problems
- We also recommend a digital drawing tablet for completing assignments and taking digital notes. Please make sure it works with your computers operating system. We recommend the XP-Pen brand linked below that can be purchased for around \$20. This is just a recommendation and not required.

Supplies Required for Students Taking Art

These supplies are required only for students taking the Middle School Art class.

- A sketchbook with unlined white or off-white paper is recommended for many assignments, but it is not required. Plain white copy paper is sufficient and is required in some assignments.



- 1 pack of white copy paper in standard white (do not get cardstock or heavy paper)
- Pencils (charcoals may be used on some assignments but are not required)
- Erasers
- Cell phone or digital camera to take photos of your work
- Black permanent marker (ex., Sharpie)
- Extra fine black permanent marker (ex., fine tip Sharpie)
- Colored pencils
- Markers
- Crayons
- Aluminum foil (just one large piece)
- Spray bottle with water

These supplies are required but will not be needed until 2nd Semester (January)

- Acrylic paint in the colors red, yellow, blue, white, and black
- Paint brushes in various sizes (just a small set)
- Artist palette or paper plates (paper plates are recommended)
- Plastic tablecloth, newspaper, trash bags, or other similar item to cover the table when painting
- 1 Canvas Board (9x12 works best, but can be any size over 8 x 11) or a piece of cardboard
- Magazines, newspapers, items from nature or around the house
- Glue or glue stick
