

Personalized Tiles

Students from CV's IDEA class will collaborate with Cheldelin Middle School students to create a large, colorful collage made up of 160 individual tiles.

Each Cheldelin student will fill out a form that will help guide IDEA students to create one multicolored square tile in Adobe Illustrator, which will then be printed and assembled into a cohesive mural. The mural will celebrate identity, creativity, and community, and will be mounted at Crescent Valley as a lasting symbol of collaboration between schools.

In preparation for this project, and to give you more Illustrator practice, you will design your own tile first.

Design Guidelines

Each student will create one tile in Illustrator following these guidelines:

- Artboard 4"x3"
- Your Name
- What You Want to Be Later in Life (career, role, or future self).
- A Meaningful Word (something that represents who you are or what matters to you).
- An Image or Symbol - something that represents what's important to you right now.

Color Scheme

- Use bright, contrasting colors that reflect your personality.
- Keep a clear background so your words/images stand out.
- Save your file as YOURFIRSTNAME, LASTNAME, Tile.ai
