



2025-2026 STC ED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

General Information

The St. Charles Education Foundation was founded in 1992 to promote excellence in education through community awareness, involvement, and philanthropy. The Ed. Foundation accepts, solicits, and disburses contributions, gifts, and bequests, from individuals, groups, or businesses to enhance educational opportunities offered students otherwise not available through regular funding resources.

One College Bound and One Skilled Trades to be presented at each of the two Awards Nights, in 2026. This is a change from previous years to emphasize an additional pathway post graduation.

The monetary value of each scholarship will be a minimum of \$1,000.00. To qualify, seniors are expected to further their education at a 2-year or 4-year college or university, vocational school, or post high school institution of higher learning. The scholarships are a one-time non-renewable award which will be granted based on overall merit. The scholarship applications are available at St. Charles North, East, and Compass Academy, guidance office and at [St. Charles Education Foundation](#).

Specific Requirements:

1. A grade point average of 3.0 or higher, to be supported by a copy of a transcript of grades. Please include a copy with the application.
2. Application to at least a two or four-year college or university, vocational school, or other post high school institution.
3. Completion of a formal, personally oriented essay of approximately 300 words on the following topic:
How have the high school experiences helped you to be prepared to grow toward being a responsible and caring citizen in the world beyond today?
Specific courses, teachers, individuals, extracurricular or work activities, or volunteer opportunities can be cited, and explained.
4. Letter of recommendation from a non-relative adult.
A teacher or administrator who knows you well or an adult outside of your respective high school. (Example: employer, civic, church or volunteer leader)
5. A list of activities both in school and out of the school environment, including honors received during the high school career.
6. Completed application MUST be mailed, post marked **MARCH 21, 2025** to the Foundation for Review of Applications.

The judging of all applications will be done by a committee of three individuals who have no eligible students at the high schools nor are voting members of the Board of Directors or Friends of the Foundation. Applications will be presented to the judging committee without identifying information and therefore, decisions will be made “blindly.” The application will be judged on meeting the specific requirements as well as the organization of ideas, sincerity, neatness, grammar, and spelling.

The winner of each \$1000 scholarship will be announced at the Senior Awards Night at the respective high school. The scholarship money will be used to fund tuition, books, fees or living expenses while enrolled in the scholarship winner’s institution of higher learning. Funds will be transferred directly to the student only after proof of registration is supplied by the student.
