***Registration for Autumn Skating School**

Registration for the autumn skating school will open in August.

***Training Schedule**

The coaches will review the groups and training schedules ahead of the autumn season. We will have largely the same training schedule as last season, with a few additions. However, skaters' schedules may vary depending on the group they belong to.

Training is expected to begin in **week 32**, including both on-ice and off-ice conditioning sessions. More information regarding schedules will be published on the website during the summer. Please remember that skaters remain in the same groups as in the spring until the new groups are announced.

Week 33: Summer Camp 2026

Weeks 34–37 and Week 40: Ice time will be somewhat reduced as more clubs will be sharing access to the ice rink. We will supplement this with additional off-ice training sessions.

Weeks 38–39 and from Week 41 through April: The regular training schedule will apply.

Schedules will be published as soon as the groups and timetable have been finalized.

***Competitions**

On **October 24–25**, we will organize a **System 2 competition** together with SKG.

Parents of skaters in the figure skating groups will be assigned work shifts during the weekend. More information will be provided in early September.
