

Step-by-Step Instructions for Finding National Risk Index Rating and Social Vulnerability Rating

1. **Go to Resilience Analysis and Planning Tool (RAPT).**

2. **Open map** by clicking on Access RAPT button. Leave website and Agree to Terms & Conditions.

3. **Access NRI Layers** by clicking on **NRI icon** to reveal a dropdown list of data sources.

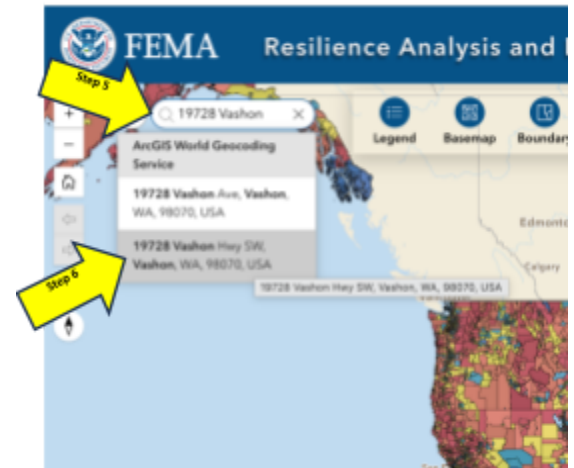


4. **Add two layers** by clicking on the check box for:

- National Risk Index Tracts and Counties
- NRI Social Vulnerability Rating

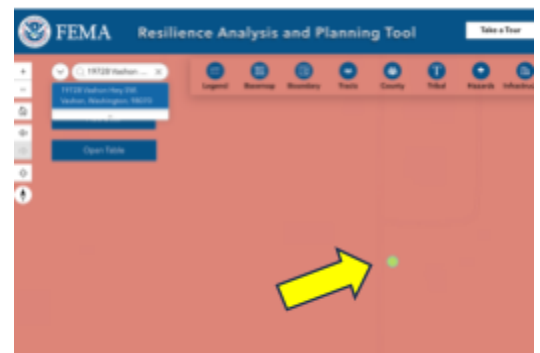
5. **Locate your church** by typing in enough of your church's street address in the search window until the full address appears in the drop-down list.

6. Click on **full address**. The map will zoom into your location.

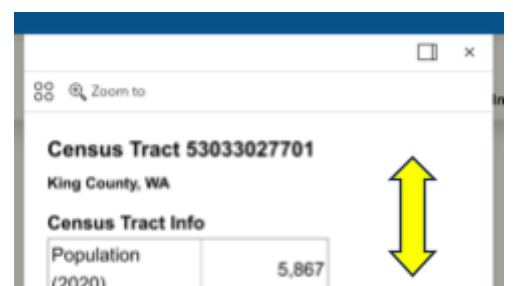
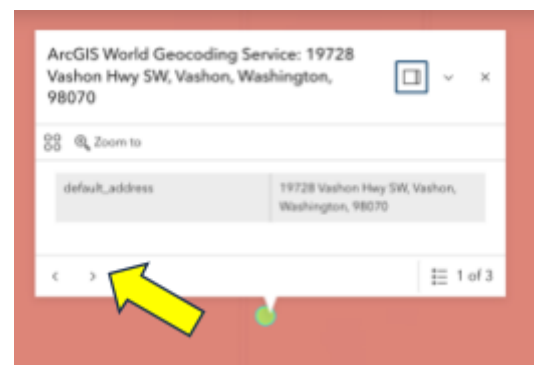


[NOTE: Make sure pop-ups are allowed for this web site, check your settings if not.]

7. **To access Summary Table**, click on location your dot.



8. **To show Summary Table**, click on right arrow for next page.



9. **Scroll in table to see “Ratings Summary”**. To scroll, right click or double tap (depending on your computer) and move the screen down until the Ratings Summary table appears.

10. Note your Risk Index and Social Vulnerability ratings. Churches with “Relatively High” or “Very High” will be prioritized in the selection process.
