Health Rules:

General Rules:

- All meat goats for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds by 8:00 pm on Sunday, July 07, 2024. Please have all health forms available on-site for check in and weigh-in. The fair office will need a copy for their records
- 2. Open and Junior shows will be combined. The shows will start at 4:00 pm on Monday, July 08, 2024.
- 3. Meat goats will be released on Monday after the completion of the show but not sooner than 8:30 pm. Please be prepared to clean out your pens, aisle and the area you occupied. Failure to do so will result in premiums being withheld.
- 4. No more than three market goats per exhibitor will be accepted.
- 5. All market goats must weigh a minimum of 40 lbs. and not be over one year of age.
- 6. All market market goats will be weighed in on the same set of scales on Sunday or Monday. ALL market goats must be weighed in before 10:30am on Monday, July 08. Exhibitors must be present at weigh-in. Scales for market goats will be open to exhibitors on Sunday, July 7 from 4:30pm to 5:30pm and Monday, July 8 from 9:00am to 10:30am.
- 7. All market goats will be mouthed. Market goats with yearling teeth will be disqualified.
- 8. All breeding goats will be shown as Crossbred, limited two per class.
- 9. All castration wounds must be healed.
- 10. Market goat showmanship and show will follow the Meat goat breeding showmanship and show. It will be time dependent if there will be a break in between shows and decisions will be made with discretion of the superintendent and judge.
- 11. Classes may be split or combined due to the number of entries at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 12. High bracing and excessive dangling of animals when braced will not be permitted.
- 13. For market pair classes, you need to have two market goats registered per exhibitor.
- 14. For breeding pair classes, you need to have two breeding goats that follow the description of pair and/or group class that animals are entered in.
- 15. Entered goats may be shown in the breeding or market show, NOT both shows, showmanship animals included.
- 16. Animals used for showmanship must be owned or leased by the exhibitor.

- 17. Mature bucks must be able to be penned on the fairgrounds around the does in surrounding pens without causing damage to pens with head ramming, body checking, ect. and/or jumping pen panels. Bucks must be able to be handled and managed easily by handlers and exhibitors around showgrounds and in the show ring. Superintendent and/or judge has the right to dismiss any mature buck entries from fairgrounds, animals class or the whole show if they feel safety of the exhibitor/ handler, or others around may be at risk.
- 18. Prohibited practices and substances:
 - a. Attaching any objects, including hair or hair substitutes, fibers, cloth, or any other object to the animal for the purpose of altering the perception of the animal.

All exhibitors are:

- subject to the General Rules and Regulations
- expected to adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics and Guidelines for the Care of Animals
- required to comply with the General Livestock Health Requirements
