- 1) Names of two candidates, preferably a female and male from two different stable geographies or if any individual wants to contest as single candidate, may apply as individual also.
- 2) Letter of support from the institutional affiliation of candidates which will host the conference in the next segment from both/individual the candidate/s
- 3) Capabilities of their institutions conducive to the successful organizing of the conference such as venue and other conference facilities, human resources, and potential funding.
- 4) The geographical venue of the prospective conference; i.e. city and country.
- 5) A vision for the APPRA

We will hold the APPRA general meeting on 11th October, 2022 during the ongoing APPRA Conference in Meghalaya and the election of the next SGs will proceed. We will consider qualities of candidates based on the proposal.
