Key Responsibilities

- Come prepared mentally, physically, emotionally, and spiritually.
- Create a welcoming environment
- Know why you are serving and who you are serving
- Attend pre-service team meeting.
- Complete Pre and Post Service Checklists (Set-up and clean-up).
- Distribute church resources (before, during, and after the service).
- Be the initiator with attendees.
- Have an eye for first-time guests
- Smile, talk to people, and learn their names!
- Be willing to help guests, answer questions, and give direction.
- Be a team player!

Additional Responsibilities For Team Leader

- Oversee the team to ensure that tasks are completed
- Do a headcount in the sanctuary (including balcony and volunteers in common spaces)

Expectations (Qualifications, Skills, and Gifts)

- People-oriented and friendly.
- Outgoing and personable.
- Cheerful and warm; easy to approach.
- Eager to welcome people to services.
- Willing to become knowledgeable of locations of various ministries and programs within the church, as well as the vision and next step opportunities.
- Able to provide knowledge yet focus more on communicating friendliness and relationships above all else.
- Gifts of hospitality, encouragement, helps, and mercy are helpful.
