Body

§1 Citation

This act may be referred to:

1. “An Act to Dissolve the Ministry of International Cooperation” as its long name.
2. “International Cooperation Ministry Dissolution Act” as it’s short name.

§2 Background

The Ministry of International Cooperation was formed to oversee events and projects related to diplomacy with other micronational organizations. Since its formation, it has been an incredibly inactive and ineffective ministry. This act proposes to abolish the ministry and transfer its duties to the Lieutenant Chair.

§3 Changes

1. Abolish the Ministry of International Cooperation.
2. Amend Article 47 of the Charter of the Cupertino Alliance, 2021, to remove the Ministry of International Cooperation from the list of active ministries.
3. Designate the Lieutenant Chair as the individual responsible for overseeing all events, projects, and duties related to cooperation with other micronational organizations.

§4 Voiding of this Act

This Act may be voided with a fifty-one percent majority vote in the Parliament of the Cupertino Alliance.
