

7 Tips for a Successful Grant Request

- 1. Pay close attention to the foundation's funding priorities which include: Program Innovation, Enrichment Programs, and Recognition of Quality Work. More details about the foundation's focus can be found at www.waukeshaeducationfoundation.org.
- 2. Talk with your principal about your request and solicit his/her support. In that process, you may learn of others in your school with similar goals or project ideas for collaboration.
- 3. Carefully read the application questions and answer completely, checking for spelling and other errors before submitting.
- 4. Explain any evidence-based research which may provide a basis for your request.
- 5. Make sure budget information is well researched. Applicants who provide specific information on how the total budget request was formulated are more successful.
- 6. Think about sustainability. Will this project continue to provide value after the first year? Or will more resources be needed to continue, and what is the plan to secure those?
- 7. Ask a colleague not familiar with the project to read your submission and provide feedback.
