## NOTES:

- Frustration with students not having stamina, not knowing where to start, not knowing where to go
- They are extremely dependent learners.... 8th grade students who missed part of 5th and most of 6th lost the transition from elementary to middle
- Students are missing basic skills in reading and math, accountability for lack of progress fall to teachers
- District does not hold students and families accountable
- Lack of accountability during remote learning has changed the expectations of students
- Parents enabling

- Incentivizing work? Because they are emotionally younger, is this something that can help motivate them?
- What are the gaps we need to fill in to help them get to where they need to be
- Teaching middle school content while also teaching literacy skills that they should have from elementary. Is there alignment and communication between elementary and secondary teaching
- Systems being in place about homework? Incentives? Where does that planning happen so we do not feel we are in an island in middle school
- Middle school needs particular systems different from high school or elementary but those systems are not in place in k-8 or 7-12
- Literacy needs will where they are for a few more years until the work in early childhood catches on
- What have people tried that is working?
  - Relationships are critical, authentic relationships the personal relationship can shift the students to be a little more driven
  - Showing and focusing on growth
  - Building confidence focusing on strengths, what they bring to the group or class
  - Showcasing their work, celebrating kids successes, birthdays, etc.
  - Leveraging 7-12 following students watching their growth
- Should we have promoted kids out of the pandemic? Should we have focused more on SEL, EF skills that first year back?
  - If nationally we had students repeated the grade would we have been better off
- Combining paper and technology...balance
- Are we trying to do too much? Are the standards realistic right now?
  - Building routines, gives students security
