3. Enter the **Non-Custodial Wallet** (Trust Wallet, Metamask) **ETH address** you would like to withdraw the NFT to.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Make sure that you are sending the NFT to a non-custodial wallet like Trust Wallet or Metamask. Sending your NFT to any ETH address that is not a non-custodial wallet owned by yourself could result in loss of the NFT.



5. The NFT will now be sent to your Non-custodial wallet. The transfer itself can take up to a few hours, so please be patient. Once received by your non-custodial wallet you should get a notification.

To confirm if your NFT has arrived in your non-custodial wallet, connect your wallet to an external marketplace like [Opensea](#) or [Blur](#) and navigate to your profile. If you are able to see the NFT like the image below, your NFT has arrived safely.



6. Click into the NFT from your profile on Opensea. Once on the NFT page, click the “3 dot drop down” and click “Refresh Metadata” This process can take up to 30 minutes. Continue to refresh the page afterwards until you see your NFT has been revealed.
