

1) Google image search the creature.



2) Copy the image you want to use (for PCs I copy their character's forum avatar).



3) Paste the image (Control-V/Command-V) into the slide




4) Crop to square (equal width and height), then resize to fit into the correct number of squares.






5) Add colored outline. I give each creature a different color (which I then use to delineate them in the initiative block), and usually set the outline thickness to 3px.

6) Optional: Make it round by selecting the oval shape from the crop menu



I tend to make PCs/Allies round, and enemies square, just to have some easy visual difference between them, as the pictures themselves can be difficult to make out when shrunk down to fit on large maps.
