Remit: Gender-Inclusive Language in the Constitution	
This remit seeks to amend CATE's Constitution to ensure that gendered pronouns (he/him, she/her) are replaced with gender-neutral pronouns (they/them), thereby ensuring our constitution is inclusive of all genders.	
Explanation & statement of case:	
Throughout the Constitution, references are made to individuals using the pronouns <i>he/him</i> and <i>she/her</i> .	
The proposed amendment is to make this change because:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- This change reflects the organisation's commitment to inclusivity and respect for all individuals regardless of gender identity.- Gender-neutral language ensures the Constitution is welcoming and representative of everyone in our community.- It aligns the organisation with current best practice in governance and diversity	
Resolution: That the Constitution be amended so that all instances of gendered pronouns (<i>he/him, she/her</i>), be replaced with the gender-neutral pronoun <i>they/them</i> .
