Project Ideas:

- Create a *commercial* or *infomercial* telling about the benefits of the 7 habits (record and save on a jump drive or USB to turn in)
- Create a *song* that shares the key concepts of the 7 habits

- Make a large *poster* that demonstrates your understanding of the 7 habits

- Publish a *newspaper* with seven articles about the 7 habits

Requirements:

- Your project must cover each of the seven habits in some way
