### 3. Results (12 Point font, before and after 10 pt, 1.5 lines)

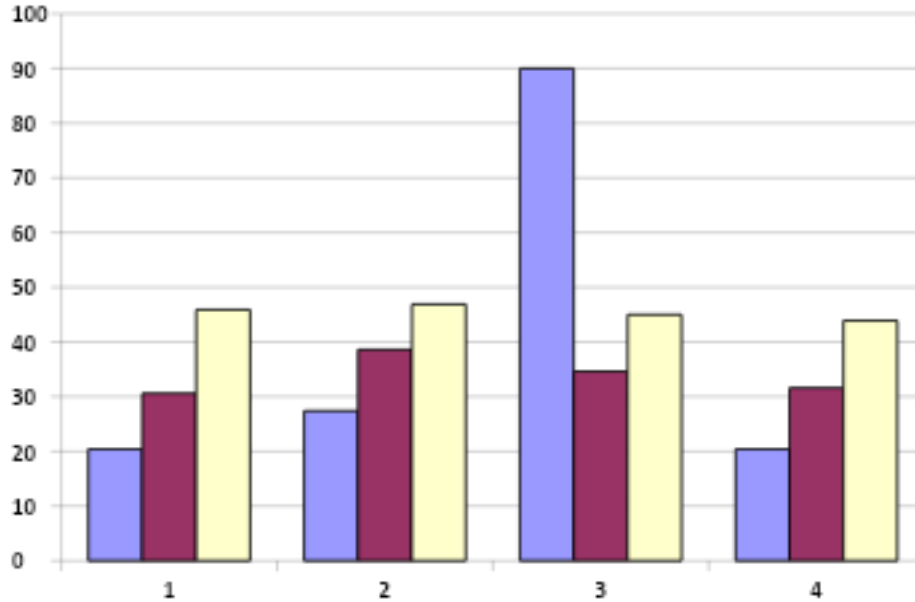
Results should be clear and concise. The most important features and trends in the results should be described but should not interpreted in detail. (first 0 pt, then 6 pt, 1.5 lines, justified)

### 4. Discussion (12 Point font, before and after 10 pt, 1.5 lines)

This section should discuss the significance of the study's results. The findings should be synthesized, compared with previous studies and/or theories, and interpreted in a way that demonstrates a clear advancement in scientific understanding. (first 0 pt, then 6 pt, 1.5 lines, justified)
