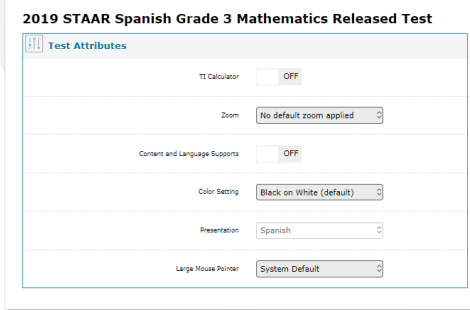




STAAR & TELPAS Practice Tests



1	Go to https://www.texasassessment.gov/practice-tests.html and find the section titled “Online Practice Tests” Click the tile/card titled “Practice Tests Login”	
2	Sign in as a “Guest User” for a “Guest Session” or toggle Guest User Off and have students sign in with their First Name and TSDS number if data needs to be collected. Click the green “Sign In” button on the screen.	
3	Choose the grade level or EOC assessment.	
4	A variety of practice tests from 2018—2025 will be available. Select the preferred test. NOTE: Please check with your district curriculum specialist for the specific STAAR released test that are NOT to be used, as items from the selected released exam will be used as part of Spring mock exams.	

5	Select the desired settings for practice. These settings are grade- and subject-specific and will vary based on the test chosen on the prior screen. After settings have been selected, click the green “Select” button on the screen. TIP: Select all available options to learn how these function.	Choose Settings: Review the following test settings. You can change the options, if necessary. 
6	If audio or video supports, including text-to-speech, were selected on the “Settings” page, the user will see a screen to customize and confirm these settings. Click the speaker icon to confirm the settings prior to the start of each test. When the settings are confirmed by the student, click the green “I heard the voice” button to continue. Note: Students using text-to-speech will need headphones if practicing in a group setting.	Audio/Video Checks Your test uses multi-media features. Please perform the following checks before continuing. Text-to-Speech Sound Check Make sure text-to-speech is working. Press the speaker button. 7	The user has an opportunity to review and change “Test Settings.” A “Help Guide” has detailed instructions for using the embedded tools. Click the green “Begin Test Now” button on the screen. Note: Some tools are grade- or subject-specific, and not all tools are available in all grade levels or subjects. 8	Administrators, teachers, and students should become familiar with the tools available on each item. For assistance, the user can return to the “Help Guide” during the test by clicking the ? in the top menu bar.

Student responses are automatically saved, so there is no need to click the “Save” button. The use of the pause button at the upper right is explained in the “Help Guide.”
9	When a response is complete for each test item, the “End Test” button will appear at the top of the screen. ← Back → Next 📄 Save 🛑 End Test
10	When “End Test” is selected, the student will have an opportunity to review any items. Items with no response will be marked with a triangle (not pictured). In the pictured example, item #12 is marked for review. The student can click this button to return to the item or can submit the test. When the student is ready to submit, they will click the green “Submit Test” button at the bottom of the page. Congratulations, you reached the end of test! If you need to review your answers, select the question number you wish to review. A flag appears for any questions that you marked for review. You have marked questions. 11	For some assessment programs, including practice, the student may then see a screen that indicates correct/incorrect responses. This format may vary slightly depending on the assessment program. This screen does not apply to all state assessment programs.
