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


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Select the desired settings for practice. These settings are grade- and subject-specific and will vary based on the test chosen on the prior screen.

**TIP:** Select all available options to learn how these function.




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If audio or video supports, including text-to-speech, were selected on the "**Settings**" page, the user will see a screen to customize and confirm these settings.
