The workshop will be held at a central Swindon location on Monday 23 March, from 12:30 - 4:30

The workshop will be a half-day facilitated session, creating space for partners to understand the Environmental Justice priorities of local communities. We want to centre the voices of trusted local organisations and the people you represent, helping to identify shared issues and ways of working together in future.

In talking of Environmental Justice we are thinking about a wide range of things that impact directly on people's lives such as:

- Warm homes and affordable energy
- Clean air
- Access to green space and nature
- Resilience in the face of climate extremes especially heat and flooding
- Access to good public transport especially bus services, and safe routes for walking and cycling
- Access to healthy food

Friends of the Earth has mapped many of these issues at ward level and in more detail, showing how they are localised across Swindon. The picture that emerges is of the communities most affected by economic and social inequalities also being those most in need of healthier and cleaner environments.

Mapping however only tells part of the story. The core of the workshop is for participants to identify and discuss which of these issues most affect you and how they impact on the lives of your communities.

We hope through this workshop to create common ground for working together more in future, starting with a Swindon Climate Summit, to be held on 22 – 23 May 2026.
