We shifted our bell schedule to accommodate the needs of students and provide additional support on E days or fridays. Also,

	implementing HERO to schedule students so it is transparent and we can track data on students who are complying with requests. We are also looking at a double lunch to lower the crowding and ability to monitor all students so they are safe and we are following the core mitigation strategies. Less students out at lunch allows us to keep the cafe, service lines orderly, increase the amount of seating and the number of students eating lunch.
