100% Dundee Hills, Revana Vineyard, 18 soil types from Volcanic to Marine Sedimentary, 30% Pommard, 23% 777, 12% Wadenswil, 12% 114, 6% 667, 6% Coury, 5% Mount Eden, 2% La Tache, 2% 943, 1% 115, 1% 113; SW exposure. Elevation: 300-650ft

Our estate vineyard is a microcosm of soil types and clones but shows more specificity of place than the Willamette Valley blend. It is Dundee Hills, but a much more powerful (Yamhill-Carlton influenced) version of the Dundee Hills.
