Subject: Update on Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) Funding

Dear Families,

We want to provide you with a clear and reassuring update regarding the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP), which many of our families rely on for child care support.

We are happy to share that current funding for CCCAP is secured through the end of February 2026. During this time, your child care assistance should continue without interruption.

The state is actively developing processes to ensure that funding extends beyond February, and we are closely monitoring these efforts. They are looking for funding sources to extend the funding far beyond the month to month funding that they are drawing down from the federal government. In addition, the Early Childhood Education Association (ECEA) is collaborating with legislators to identify long-term industry solutions that will help reduce pressure on CCCAP and create more sustainable support for Colorado families and providers.

Everyone involved—including state agencies, advocacy groups, and child care providers—is working diligently to resolve any enrollment freezes and to secure ongoing federal funding for the program.

Please know that your child's care and your family's stability are our top priorities. If any unexpected changes occur that could affect CCCAP, we will notify your child care provider immediately so they can communicate with you promptly and help you plan accordingly. We are committed to keeping you informed and ensuring no one is caught off guard.

Thank you for trusting us with your children each day. We are grateful to partner with you and will continue to advocate for the resources our families and community need.
