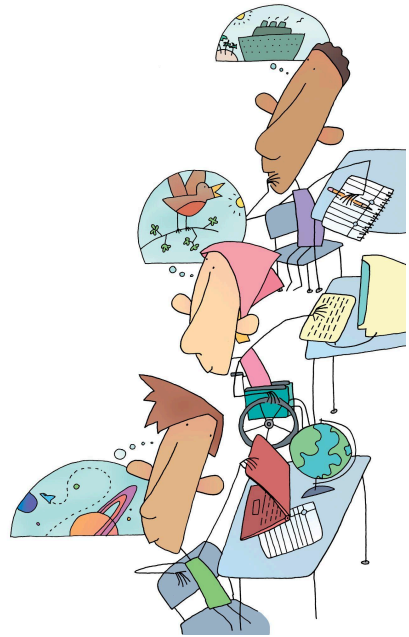
End-of-Year Writing Survey
