Valle del Sol

Valle Del Sol offers several mental health services and treatment for addictions, including court-ordered treatment, crisis intervention (along with people who can help the person in crisis sign up for other services), Hepatitis C Screening, individual, family, and group counseling and psychiatric evaluations. These services are for youth and adults. In addition, youth also have a "Good Grief Program" and a "Girls Resiliency Group." Most of the programs are available to people with AHCCCS/Mercy Maricopa Behavioral Health. Other insurance is welcome. Psychiatric evaluations cost \$160. There is a waiting list. Please call to set up an appointment. Language: English and Spanish. *Walk-in intakes are 8am-12pm every Wednesday and Thursday. Please bring birth certificate and insurance information. * Most programs are open to people with AHCCCS/Magellan Behavioral Health Care or other insurance or private pay. Psychiatric evaluations cost \$160. There is a wait list, so call to get on the list. Some programs are free.
