Multiple Intelligences and Learning Styles

Powerful Instruction – Dynamic Education "How smart are you?" or is it "How are you smart?"

The second question is empowering: it is an acknowledgment that all people are smart and that we achieve our intelligence in varied and unique ways. Intelligence is not a static reality that is fixed at birth. It is a dynamic, ever-growing, changing reality throughout one's life. Intelligence can be improved, expanded, and amplified. The only limit to one's intelligence seems to be individual beliefs about what is possible.

There are many forms of intelligence, and many ways through which students know and understand themselves and the world they live in. Howard Gardner - a pioneer in the field of Multiple Intelligences - discovered that there were at least seven types of intelligences. In fact, he believes that understanding how a child gains knowledge is key to whether or not a child "becomes educated." If we can determine the innate abilities/skills that a child possesses, those skills will direct the focus of that child's education. Again, we are asking the question for each student "How are you smart?"

Your personal understanding of your child, how they learn, and what they learn are the keys to their success. It is a widely accepted fact that the parent's attitudes about the value of learning and education are key to the success of the student. The human brain is still very plastic in elementary school and even into middle school and high school. The brain is changed by what comes into it: early experiences do make a difference in the way that the cells in the brain connect up. What is practiced over and over again by the brain develops physical connectivity that "sticks in there." A brain that has played a lot of video games is going to be differently constructed from a brain that spent that same amount of time reading or engaging in active play. Our mission is to support you and your developing student on this incredible journey. Your participation here at SVA suggests that the pursuit of learning is
