

Directing Role-Play

SUBJECT: Film

SUMMARY: Become a Film Director! The director is in charge of the actors and the direction of the story in a production. They make sure the feeling of the story is portrayed correctly through the actors and cinematography. A key to being a successful director is to understand exactly what the story is and to know exactly how YOU want it to look like!

MATERIALS NEEDED: Paper and writing utensil or computer.

DIRECTIONS:

- Write your own short scene or choose one from a movie or tv show. The scene must include at least three lines of dialogue.
- Next to each line of dialogue or character action, write the emotion the character should be expressing.
- After you have completed your script including what the characters are doing, saying, and feeling, find someone to act it out (no physical contact or fighting). Put on your best directing attitude (confident) to help coach your actor through how they should FEEL as they perform.
- Have fun with it and Keep going until it is perfect! Remember to call "Action" and "Cut"!

Line: You cannot not pass! *Emotion: Determined & fearless.*
