Algebra I Honors is recommended for students with above average mathematical and problem solving skills. The purpose of Algebra I Honors is the continued development of critical thinking skills & problem solving techniques needed to conceptually understand & apply algebraic systems for solving problems. Students will be expected to demonstrate proficiency in solving complex equations & inequalities; in graphing linear, quadratic, absolute value, & exponential functions; in application of skills by solving real-life problems.

Absences: Students are responsible for all work missed due to absence. All tests and quizzes not made up within a reasonable time frame will result in a zero. Any homework missed due to an absence, should be turned in ASAP and is the responsibility of the student to seek out and show the teacher in order to receive credit. If you are dismissed during the day, you are still responsible for the hw assignment. If you cut class, you will be given a zero on ALL assignments that day.

Come to class & Be on time.

Please do your best to arrive virtually and physically on time. Attendance will be taken daily for both types of students. If for some reason you are unable to attend physically, please log in virtually so that you don't miss class. All "live" lessons will be recorded and posted on google classroom for you to revisit at a later time.

Do your Homework & Classwork
