

# **FAQs for the Transition for the Rosa Parks Afterschool Program**

## ***When does registration start for the 2022-23 school year?***

Registration for the 2022-23 school year starts on April 18 at 9:00 a.m. through the [LEARNS Registration website](https://go.asapconnected.com/?org=4884) - <https://go.asapconnected.com/?org=4884>.

## ***What is the registration process?***

For LEARNS, families register their children by grade level for the upcoming school year. All applicants are placed on a waitlist. Program Specialists then enroll students with priority given as follows:

1. Foster youth, students who are experiencing homelessness, and students qualifying for Free and Reduced Price Meals
2. Students currently enrolled in the program (exception will be made to include pre-COVID-19 enrollment due to limited staffing)
3. Siblings of current students
4. Date of enrollment

## ***What are the hours of the program?***

The before school program runs from 7:30 a.m.-start of the school day and the after school program runs from dismissal-6:00 p.m.

## ***What happens in the after school program on an average day?***

The schedule for an average day is as follows:

- 2:15-3:30 p.m. - Receive students, provide snack, and recreation/activity time (TK-Kindergarten)
- 3:00-3:30 p.m. - Receive students, provide snack, and conduct group check-in outside
- 3:30-4:30 p.m. - Academic time - read aloud or silent reading, homework support, academic support, and meet with BUILD mentors
- 4:30-5:30 p.m. - Outside recreation time and/or enrichment classes
- 5:30-6:00 p.m. - Guided free choice and clean up

## ***How is the program staffed?***

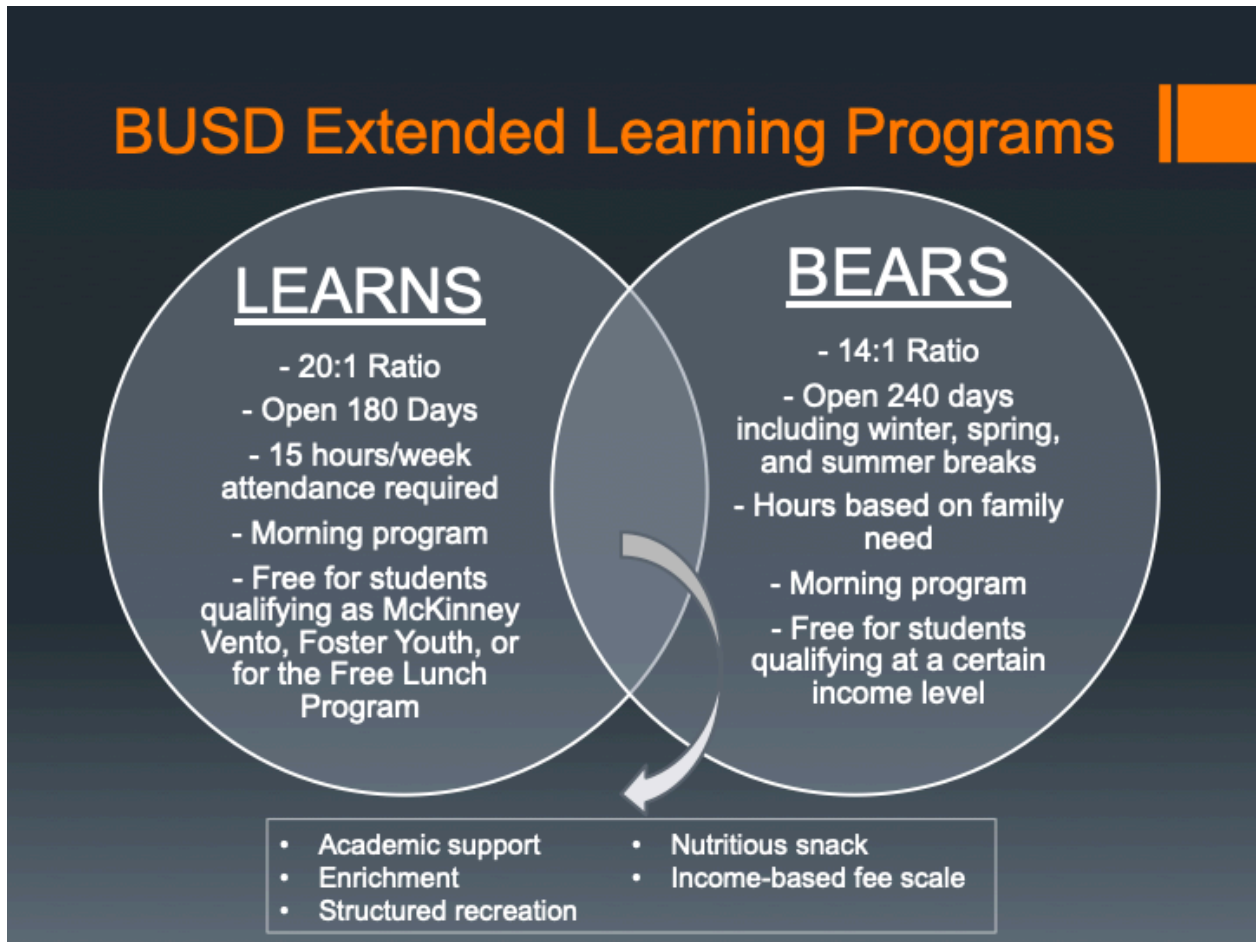
The staff is composed of trained Instructional Technicians leading grade-level student groups. They are led by a Program Specialist who coordinates programming and administrative tasks for the program. All District employees complete a stringent application process that includes testing, interviews, and a background check prior to employment.

**Who can enroll in the program?**

All students enrolled at Rosa Parks in TK-5th grade may enroll in BEARS or LEARNS.

**What is the difference between BEARS and LEARNS?**

The BEARS and LEARNS program are separate due to separate funding sources. Following is a diagram that explains the differences and similarities between the programs:
