Dear fifth grade families,

The School District of New Berlin believes that the family plays a crucial role in students' human growth and development education. The schools support both parents/guardians and children in their efforts to develop an understanding of puberty, human sexuality, and the family. Because of this, we will have a human growth and development lesson on Monday, April 15th. Since this lesson is a part of our science/health curriculum, we will be addressing it in the context of one of the many body systems we are studying. The main focus of the lesson will be growing up/body changes and the reproductive system, hygiene, and good health choices. On Monday, April 15th we will be teaching separate sessions for the boys and girls with a male teacher and/or administrator leading the boys and a female teacher and/or administrator leading the girls.

The curriculum will include preparing for puberty, vocabulary and definitions, similarities and differences in boys and girls, physical anatomy, personal hygiene, and nutrition. We will be using a video, handouts, and discussions for this instruction. Parents can view all materials (located here.) prior to (put date here) by contacting your child's teacher.

While we introduce human anatomy terminology and function in the 5th grade Human Growth and Development unit, we believe it is up to parents when and how to introduce human reproduction if they chose to do this prior to our 8th grade Health course.
