All materials placed in the pile must be in their natural form – stumps, pine needles, branches, logs, etc. *No treated or painted wood, nails, spikes, etc. are allowed.*
- We have a printed directory and map available listing all property owners in Wold. Please let us know if you need one. Both are available electronically too. Just send an email if you need one emailed to you.
- IMPORTANT: Cell phones do not consistently reach the correct Dispatch Center when you call 911. It depends on which tower the call originates from.
