#### **Behavioral Expectations:**

As we transitioned back to the building this year, staff understood the anxiety and unease some students might be feeling having not attended daily due to COVID and have provided grace when intervening with behavioral issues. Now that we have been in school for a quarter, we are transitioning back toward our pre-pandemic approaches throughout the building. ### **Behavioral Expectations**

#### **Veterans Day Program:**

We will be having a Veterans Day program here on November 11th starting at 2:20 pm. This is not a public event, but we have been working with the American Legion Post 36 to invite Veterans in our community to attend. We have many students involved in this program from delivering the opening remarks, to singing, to playing instruments, to serving treats to our veterans after the program. #### **End of Quarter 1:**

Quarter 1 ends on Monday, November 8th. This is simply a check point in time for students and a reminder that we issue final grades at semester only. Teachers will have updated gradebooks in Skyward for parents and students to check progress in their learning. Remember, grades are not about the points gathered or the percentage earned, grades are about the learning that occurs.

#### **Academic Supports have begun:**
