

Trucking Insurance Renewal Checklist

If you're leased on or running under your own authority, here's what to have ready when renewing your insurance policy.

1. Vehicle & Driver Updates

- Make sure your truck/trailer list is current
- Remove any units you're no longer using
- Double check your driver roster: name, date of birth, CDL state/number, and experience

2. Docs You'll Likely Need

- Last 3 to 5 years of **Loss Runs** (ask your current agent if you're unsure)
- **IFTA Reports** for the past 4 quarters
- **EIN** and cargo details (be specific: paper, reefer, hazmat, etc.)
- **MC/DOT number** status

3. Coverage & Billing

- Review your liability, cargo, non-trucking liability, physical damage, occupational accident
- Ask if you can split policies (sometimes cheaper)
- Check your billing plan (monthly, escrow, finance company)

4. Cert Holders

- Make a list of all certificate holders and any special wording (waiver of subrogation, primary/non-contributory, additional insured etc.)
