Agenda Review & Disposition: no changes

Minutes of August 13: On a motion by Mr. Damon seconded by Mr. Desloge the board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of August 13, 2025.

Privilege of the Floor #1: Mrs.Kelley discussed with the board the tradition of the middle school team building the first week of school. Discussion Items:

- 1. Facility Update: Mr. Andrews discussed the roof project, it has been completed. The boiler project came in under budget. There were two existing pumps that were designed to work with the system not working as well as they would like, the consensus is to replace the pumps. The cost of the pumps should be under the amount that is remaining for the project. There was discussion about who recommended the change. There has been communication with Mark, Tom, CCI, and the Engineer. It was thought that what is there would work but it doesn't.
- **2. Board Retreat/Time:** The October board meeting will be moved to the 15th at 6:00, the board retreat will start at 6:30.
- 3. Bring Your Own Device Policy Rescind: Mr. Andrews discussed that this policy doesn't apply any longer. A motion by Ms. Pearce seconded by Ms. DiSalvo to rescind the policy. Discussion about if there is anything we want to keep. We are following school rules. There was discussion about use on buses being covered, we need to follow rules of the bus and handle any issues on a case by case bus. Discussion about expectation of privacy. The board voted unanimously to rescind the policy.
- 4. Use and Location of Automated External Defibrillators KFD 1st Reading: Mr. Andrews discussed we don't have a policy for this yet. We are following this now, we just need to put it into a policy. Discussed purchasing one to travel with sports, or for the front office. There was discussion about the section talking about who can use it. NH has no duty to intervene for emergencies and no liability. Mr. Andrews will get some clarification or options for language.
