SOAR:

SOAR stands for Student Opportunity & Academic Responsibility. This will be a time for students to get needed support in their learning as well as joining staff for enrichment activities. The bell schedule is modified on these days allowing for students to have each class (on shortened periods) and have 90+ minutes in the afternoon to participate in SOAR. Students will be able to sign up for these different sessions during the school day on Tuesday (the sign up window opens at 7:40am and closes at 3:30pm).
