



Parking Checkpoint Pass

Vehicle parking will be in the Chemistry Lot behind Gross Hall. The gate is at this location https://goo.gl/maps/bKL6JFkYM2pJ7tb39. Entrance is granted using the QR below. This parking pass must be on the dashboard of ALL vehicles to get to and from the designated parking area. The PDF of this can also be found in the Google Drive link sent with this email. The QR should function from 5 am - 10 pm on the day of the event.

For teams bringing buses, bus parking is not in the Chemistry Lot. Instead, buses should park in the parallel spaces on Towerview rd between Circuit Drive and Erwin Rd. If these spaces are full, there is additional bus parking in the Duke Gardens parking spaces. See images attached for bus parking.

If a student has not filled out a form and uploaded it by the date of the invitationals, they will not be allowed to compete and if they do, their scores will be voided.

Honor Code Agreement

The Honor Code will be a testament for all students to agree to follow Science Olympiad and DUSO policies when competing. Every student will be required to fill out the Honor Code when taking a test. (It will be attached to the front of the test, and the student will have to sign it before moving onto the remaining content).

Check-in and Pick-up Locations

Check in will take place in the Old Chemistry building's lobby, where we will give out wristbands. Pizza pickup will take place in Physics 128. Check-in will start at 7:15 AM. Food that was pre-ordered will be available around 11 AM.

Awards Ceremony

The Awards Ceremony will be in Gross Hall 107. Because of the relatively small projector size, we ask that active competitors fill in towards the front with up to 1 coach per school, and that all other adults, chaperones, alternates, etc. sit towards the back and or in the overflow area where we will broadcast the awards. We will have signage and people to guide everyone, but we would appreciate the coaches conveying this information to students and parents beforehand.

Wristband Policy

We require all competitors to wear wristbands. These will be given to the coach at the morning check-in.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What forms need to be filled out for the Invitational?

A: Students need to fill out the Student Participation Agreement Form linked within the Coaches' Packet, and coaches must fill out the Vandalism and Behavior form for their entire team.

Q: What is the policy on alternates?

A: We use the official national rules on alternates. Which means that alternates do not get to compete unless one of the 15 official team members CANNOT compete. https://www.soinc.org/what-official-rule-alternate-team-members#:~:text=Alternates %20may%20participate%20only%20if,the%20day%20of%20the%20competition

Q: How many awards will there be?

A: We will give awards to the top 5 teams per event and top 5 overall schools - which means if a school has two teams place in the top 5, then only the higher ranking team will receive a trophy and the sixth ranked school will be bumped up.
