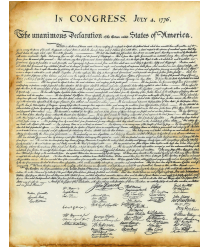


Kenilworth

Declaration Poster

*Create your own
Declaration of Independence.*



There is something really WRONG with your school right now and you need to make changes. You and your friends have rallied up and are ready to create your ideal school. The school of your dreams...

Necessary requirements:

1. Catchy Title (with the name of the new school)

Your title must only be positive. It cannot have any negative words. Also it may not include Kenilworth or Kolts in the title. Include the purpose of the Junior high school

2. Statement of Beliefs

Write about what you believe a good school is supposed to be. Try to use only positive statements.

(Exclude words like “No” and “Not” in your statements.

Good Example: Bad Example: A school shouldn't serve junk food for lunch.)

I believe a good school should provide nutritious food.

3. List of Grievances (COMPLAINTS!)

Think about your list of grievances (or *complaints*).

How Kenilworth has violated those ideas about what a good school is supposed to be?

Kenilworth never provides nutritious lunches. They always serve greasy pizza.

4. Declaration of a New School

Declare the creation of a new school with two sentences. Declare the name of the school and also how this school is going to be awesome. Also, you may want to include where the school will be.

5. List of Signatures and Your Names

a. 20 signatures from the Class

b. Put your names in the top right hand corner on the back of the document with your Heading.

You can use these ideas and starters (BE CREATIVE)

1. Catchy Title (with the name of the new school)

(example) *The Unanimous Declaration of (NAME OF YOUR NEW SCHOOL)*

Alternative Words for Declaration: *Statement, expression, affirmation, assertion, announcement, communique*
If you have time, color in the title or make it bold with dark markers, crayons, or colored pencils.

2. Statement of Beliefs What is a good government? What is a good school? What is a school? A school is a place to learn and receive an education.
3. List of Grievances

A good school helps students with their needs for learning:

It needs to protect the children so they feel safe to learn.

A good teacher who knows how to teach

A warm place

Food in the lunch area to help students focus.
