
Panopto - Create Student Assignment

Panopto can be used to create a submission link for students to create their own videos. These videos can be used for presentations, introductions, showing a process, or any topic you want students to create a video for assessment.

1. To create an assignment for students to submit a video, log into EduCat, click into your course, and turn **Editing mode** on in the upper right corner.




Go to the section where you would like the assignment to be displayed. Click on Add an activity or resource.



3. Select Panopto - Student Assignment









To access the student submitted videos click on the activity you created.



10. Click Grade.




11. This gives you the assignment grading interface that is very similar to any assignment. **Click Grade** next to the student whose submission you would like to view.



12. This screen will show you your **student's video submission**. You can either watch it on your current screen in Educat or choose to watch the expanded view in Panopto with the diagonal arrow button in the bottom right corner.


You can also download the video if you would like to keep it for your records. **Click the download button** in the bottom right corner.



13. Below the video, you can enter the **grade** that you would like to give to the student.

You can leave any comments that you might have in the **Feedback box**.

You can also choose if you would like the student to be notified of their grade.



14. Once you **click Save changes**, the gradebook will be updated.
