Staff Dress

Staff members project an image to the community and to students about the professionalism of the public charter school. The dress limitations for students apply to staff. The executive director has the final authority to decide what attire is acceptable for staff.

Unacceptable Attire

The following items are deemed disruptive to the educational environment or to the maintenance of a safe and orderly school and are not acceptable in public charter school buildings, on school grounds or at school-sponsored activities when staff is on duty:

- 1. Any clothing, paraphernalia, grooming, jewelry, hair coloring, accessories or body adornments that contain any advertisement, symbols, words, slogans, patches or pictures that:
 - a. Refer to drugs, tobacco, alcohol or weapons;
 - b. Are of sexual nature;
 - c. By virtue of color, arrangement, trademark or other attribute denote membership in gangs which advocate drug use, violence or disruptive behavior;
 - d. Are obscene, profane, vulgar, lewd or legally libelous;
 - e. Threaten the safety and welfare of any person;
 - f. Promote any activity prohibited by the student code of conduct;
 - g. Otherwise disrupt the teaching-learning process.

Exceptions

- 1. Appropriate athletic clothing may be worn when teaching or assisting with physical education classes or coaching athletic activities.
- 2. Other exceptions will be allowed for staff with specific job assignments such as but not limited to food service, custodians, professional technical and/or fine arts with permission from the executive director or designee.
